The boat had to be versatile enough to satisfy all sailing pleasures, and easy enough to sail so that all the members of a family could participate. So easy and so much fun to sail 'EYGTHERE 24' points high and goes fast to windward while her ample sail area gives her brilliant performance on every point of sailing in all wind strengths. The helm is balanced and featherlight so that the children can take their turns for long periods.

The beautifully proportioned seaworthy hull has sufficient flair and freeboard to keep the crew dry when sailing to windward and ensures safety and comfort when sailing offshore. All sheets and halliards lead back to the spacious cockpit for ease of working when sailing short handed.

The high double guard rails, wide flat side decks and inboard mast stays make it child's play to go forward for easy sail changing on the clear foredeck.

The masthead rig and substantially built mast need no fancy tuning and the 2,000 lb. keel keeps 'EYGTHERE 24' stiff and stable under sail, even with all the family snug below. Easy to steer and control, one has the feeling of complete confidence at all times.

The comfortable accommodation, fully insulated, with a separate internal lining and beautifully finished with solid teak, provides berths for five in two separate cabins, a galley unit, hanging and dry lockers and ample storage space.

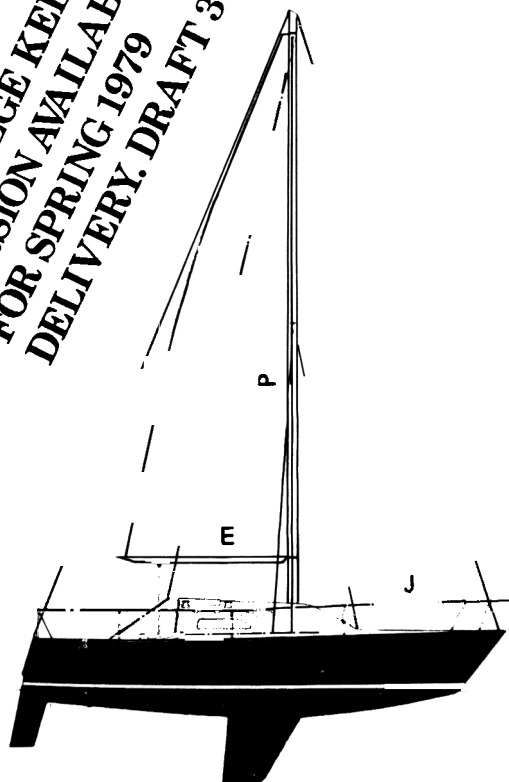

SPECIFICATION OF THE BUDGET BOAT AND EQUIPMENT:—

HULL

A hand - laid fibreglass/balsa sandwich construction using resins and materials of the highest quality. Lloyds approved. Standard colour - white. Optional colours, red or dark blue.

DECK

A hand laid moulding of fibreglass/balsa construction for strength and insulation. The working surfaces are painted in grey non - slip paint. The roomy cockpit is self draining. Anchor lockers with external access. Standard colour - off white

KEEL

A fine grained high quality iron casting of 2,000 lbs. Aerofoil section. Secured to hull with 6 of 3/4" diameter keel bolts through oak bearers to Lloyds rules.

RUDDER

1 1/2" stainless steel stock

MAST

Anodised aluminium mast with tubular spreaders, with integral mainsail slider groove. Provision for all halliards to be internal and all lead back to halliard winches and cleats and worked from the cockpit. Kicking strap to boom. Boom with integral sail groove and provision for slab reefing.

RIGGING

Stainless steel standing rigging with stainless steel rigging screws. Genoa and main halliards. Main and genoa sheets in soft plait terylene.

DECK FITTINGS

Stainless steel pulpit, stanchions fitted with plastic covered guardrails. Sternhead roller, 9" mooring cleat, 2 x2 - speed sheet winches, 6 cleat, 2 halliard winches, mainsheet roller track with slide and adjusting tackle (fitted on bridge deck), 2 of 5ft. Genoa tracks with sliding leads, ventilator above galley, 2 of teak grab rails on coachroof, anodised aluminium forehatch, black anodised aluminium toe rail. Hinged laminated tiller.

BULKHEADS

The teak faced marine ply to B.S. 1088 bulkheads are jig - bonded into the hull whilst still in the mould to ensure accuracy.

INTERIOR

All accommodation moulding in GRP with solid teak trim and joinery. Two berth forecabin with hatch to deck, clothes lockers, toilet compartment to port, hanging locker to starboard, Saloon: Galley unit, L - shaped settee berth, 2 quarter berths, clothes lockers.

LINING

Fore and main cabin deck head are lined with a GRP moulding.
